Performance Summary.

This past year has been exceptional for our placement department. Out of 498 students registered with the UCC Placement Cell, 223 actively participated in the placement drives, with 164 successfully securing job offers. Our students received offers from a wide range of industries, including technology, finance, consulting, healthcare, manufacturing, research and development, IT, non-IT, and teaching sectors, with some receiving offers from 3 to 4 organizations. The salary packages ranged from a minimum of Rs.1.80K to a maximum of Rs 4.5K CTC annually. We conducted 23 career orientation sessions and numerous skill development workshops, contributing to our students' success. Additionally, our alumni network played a crucial role in mentoring and preparing students for the placement process. Looking ahead, we aim to expand our network of recruiters and continue enhancing our programs to ensure our students' professional success.

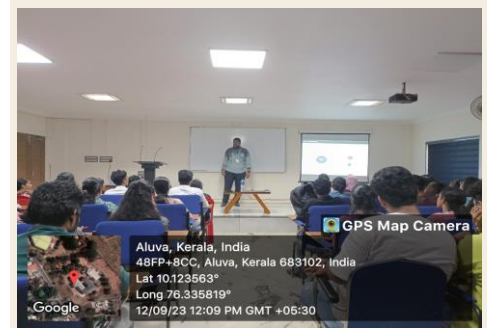

Eligibility

- **Registration Requirement:** Candidates must be registered with the UCC Placement Cell to participate in all placement activities, including placement drives.
- **Mandatory PAN Card:** A PAN card is mandatory. If you do not have a PAN card, the Placement Cell will assist you in applying for one.
- **Bank Account:** A bank account in your own name is required.
- **Academic Criteria:** Candidates with back papers are not eligible to attend recruitment processes for MNCs or banks, as stipulated by the respective organizations.
- **Minimum Attendance:** Ensure a minimum attendance of 75% in all training and development sessions organized by the Placement Cell.
- **Disciplinary Record:** Candidates must have a clean disciplinary record. Any history of misconduct may result in disqualification from the placement process.
- **Skill Certifications:** Certain job roles may require specific skill certifications. Ensure you meet these criteria before applying.
- **Academic Projects:** Completion of mandatory academic projects may be required for certain placements.
- **Pre-Placement Training:** Participation in pre-placement training sessions organized by the Placement Cell is mandatory.

Point to be noted

- **Internships:** Internships are crucial for building a strong career foundation.
- **Effort Distribution:** For a successful career, the Placement Cell contributes 20% only, while candidates must contribute 80%.
- **Application Precision:** Avoid registering for irrelevant job openings.
- **Job Details:** Carefully review job details before submitting your application.
- **Age Criteria:** Candidates aged 18 and above are eligible for internships and part-time work, provided these do not interfere with their studies.
- **Professionalism:** Maintain a professional demeanour in all interactions.
- **Resume Updates:** Regularly update your resume to reflect new skills, experiences, and achievements.
- **Interview Preparedness:** Attend all pre-interview training sessions offered by the Placement Cell.
- **Communication Skills:** Work on enhancing your communication skills, as they are critical during interviews.
- **Feedback Utilization:** Use feedback from mock interviews and training sessions to improve your performance.
- **Networking:** Engage in networking activities to connect with industry professionals and alumni.
- **Dress Code:** Adhere to the prescribed dress code for all placement-related activities.
- **Follow-Up:** After interviews, promptly follow up with thank-you emails to show appreciation and reinforce your interest.
- **Career Planning:** Engage in career planning sessions to align your job search with your long-term career goals.
- **Application Deadlines:** Adhere to all application deadlines. Late submissions will not be considered.
- **Document Verification:** Ensure all documents (transcripts, ID proofs, certificates) are up-to-date and verified.
- **Digital Presence:** Maintain a professional digital presence, including a polished LinkedIn profile.
- **Mock Interviews:** Participate in mock interviews to gain confidence and receive constructive feedback.
- **Technical Skills:** Continuously update your technical skills to match industry requirements.
- **Soft Skills:** Develop soft skills such as teamwork, problem-solving, and adaptability.
- **Industry Knowledge:** Stay informed about industry trends and developments to demonstrate your awareness during interviews.
